Additional add-on to **Nyere National Park** and will be transferred to **Selous Impala Camp** for 3 nights full board.

Nyere is one of the least visited parks. It was previously known as Selous Game Reserve and is the largest national park in Africa. The park is situated in the southeastern region of Tanzania. It's a lesser-known destination and, is less crowded than the popular northern parks in Tanzania, which gives it a wilder and more private atmosphere. The park is home to many species, including a good population of African Wild Dogs and the Big 5.
